STEPS TO ENROLLMENT

- Apply for admission on AHC website
- Set up <u>myHancock portal</u> and email
- **Download** forms from AHC website
- Obtain **signatures**:
 - a. parent
 - b. high school principal/designee
- Request unofficial transcript from your high school
- Submit completed and signed forms AND unofficial transcripts to admissions
- Once cleared, enroll in classes through myHancock portal
- Pay fees (if applicable)
