<ul> <li>GRANTS</li> <li>FREE MONEY for educational expenses based on financial need</li> <li>Main types: <ul> <li>Cal-Grant</li> <li>Pell Grant</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul> <li>WORK STUDY</li> <li>Jobs to help pay for school</li> <li>Employment on campus</li> <li>Up to 15 hrs per week</li> </ul>
<ul> <li><b>LOANS</b></li> <li>Money on loan which must be paid back with interest</li> <li>Two types: <ul> <li>Subsidized: Government pays down interest while in school</li> <li>Unsubsidized: Automatic monthly payments</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul> <li>SCHOLARSHIPS</li> <li>FREE MONEY based on specific requirements or criteria</li> <li>Main types: <ol> <li>On campus</li> <li>National</li> <li>Local (High School)</li> </ol> </li> </ul>
